



## Weiti Boating Club (INC.)

### TRAILER PARK GUIDELINES

These guidelines have been put in place to make sure everyone using the Trailer Park are aware of their responsibilities. If these guidelines are abused then Weiti Boating Club have the right to ask you to move your boat.

- 1) When arriving at the trailer park early in the morning or late at night, noise must be kept to a minimum so not to disturb the neighbours. Outboards are only allowed to be started on the boat ramp
- 2) Maintenance work to outboards are not allowed in the Trailer Park area, you must use the Hardstand area between the shed and the road. There will be no charge to use this area for short periods during the day, for longer periods of time you must book a place on the Hardstand. General maintenance work that does not make any noise is allowed in the trailer park area.

**PLEASE NOTE: IF YOU ARE CAUGHT REVVING YOUR ENGINE OR DOING MAINTENANCE WORK TO YOUR OUTBOARD IN THE TRAILER PARK AREA YOU WILL BE GIVEN ONE WARNING, THE SECOND TIME YOU WILL BE ASKED TO REMOVE YOUR BOAT FROM THE TRAILER PARK AREA.**

- 3) No flushing of engines in trailer park, can only be done by the shed between 9am – 6pm
- 4) Tractors/cars shall not be left attached to the trailer once the boat is launched, tractor or car should be parked in the car park separately
- 5) Halyards on boats need to be tied down
- 6) Tractors to be fitted with a muffler
- 7) All Trailer sailors with masts erected must use the side road by the shed and do not drive along Fairhaven Walk as there are power lines. Your dinghy locker key will unlock the chain by the shed.
