

HAULAGE INFORMATION

An application to haul out can only be made by submitting a completed and signed haulout form to the club manager. Forms are available from the website, clubhouse and office.

All maintenance activities on the ramp and hardstand must comply with Weiti Boating Club's policies. The policies are available from the website, clubhouse and office. Each member shall provide, to the manager, signed and dated copies of the policy documents before his/her boat will be hauled.

The yard and shed are available for maintenance work and moderate repairs only. Major reconstruction, new boat building and the storage of boats are expressly forbidden.

The maximum time allowed in the yard or shed is three months. A member undertaking a refit lasting longer than three months must obtain formal permission from the general committee before proceeding.

The maximum vessel weight that will be hauled or moved in the yard is 10 tonnes. If a vessel's weight is in doubt, an independent weight certificate shall be provided at the owner's expense before a haulout will be scheduled.

The boat owner is responsible for setting-up the cradle and ensuring it is fit for purpose well in advance of the haulout date. Wooden keel blocks, chine blocks and packers must be robustly secured to the cradle.

The cradle will be inspected by the club's tractor operator prior to hauling. The operator has total discretion to refuse a haulout if a cradle is thought to be unsuitable or unsafe, however, the operator's inspection does not diminish the owner's responsibility in any way.

When hauling out, shifting or relaunching a vessel, the owner must organise, brief and instruct two additional fit people to assist with the work. Everyone must be on-site two hours prior to hauling.

Owners of large trailerable yachts and launches with their own trailer, but not requiring a club operator or club equipment, shall make a booking with the club manager. Normal charges apply where applicable.

Sand blasting, bead blasting and spray painting are not permitted in the yard or the shed.

All ladders must be securely padlocked to the cradle when not in use to deter thieves and vandals entering boats in the yard.

All dislodged marine growth, paint scrapings, sanding dust, saw dust, shavings, paint tins, yard sweepings, food scraps and small items must be placed in heavy duty sealed plastic bags before being deposited in the rubbish bin. Members must supply the rubbish bags.

Fee Payment

All haulout, hardstand and shed fees will be invoiced on a monthly basis; the balance shall be paid not later than the 20th of the month following the month to which the charges relate. All charges and fees must be paid in full prior to launching the boat or removing it from the yard.
