### NOTICE OF RACE

#### 1.0 Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the World Sailing Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part II, **Category 4** shall apply.
- 1.3 All yachts must be equipped with a VHF radio capable of transmitting and receiving on all channels
- 1.4 Extras:
  - a) Extras are defined as sails not usually used to advantage to windward.
  - b) Divisions 1 & 3 boats may fly extras (no more than 2 spinnakers carried in race).
  - c) Division 2 is non-spinnaker (no extras).
- 1.5 The Marauder Class Rules will apply with the following exceptions:
  - a) Keel stepped masts will be permitted.
  - b) No 1 genoa may be hanked, foil or furler.
  - c) No 2 genoa must be smaller than No 1 but does not need to conform to the class size. However only one No 2 genoa may be included in the sail wardrobe for this regatta.
- 1.6 Code of Conduct: Competitors shall comply with any reasonable request from a regatta official.

#### 2.0 Eligibility & Entry

- 2.1 Entries will be accepted from Marauder Yachts registered with YNZ and whose owners/skippers are financial members of a yacht club affiliated to YNZ.
- 2.2 Boats entering races must display their correct registration numbers on sails in accordance with the Rule 77 of the World Sailing Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 2.3 To be eligible to compete in this event the Owner or Skipper shall be a financial or "New Owner" member of the Marauder 8.4 Owner's Association and only Marauders that meet the standard Marauder 8.4 design rules shall be eligible for Marauder 8.4 Association trophies for Division 1 and 2.
- 2.4 Entries must be made to the Weiti Boating Club using the online entry form on the Club's website, with payment of the designated entry fee. Entries will **not** be accepted using printed entry forms.
- 2.5 **Entrants must provide a mobile phone number that they can be contacted on while racing.**
- 2.6 WBC reserve the right to accept or refuse any entry.
- 2.7 Entries must be received, and fees paid by **Wednesday 3rd April**.

Entry Fees: \$55 per boat.

#### 3.0 Schedule of Races

<u>Day</u>	<u>Date</u>	<u>No of Races</u>	<u>First warning signal</u>
Saturday	6th <sup>th</sup> April 2019	Up to four W/L races	0955
Sunday	7th <sup>th</sup> April 2019	Up to two races-Harbour or/and W/L	0855

In the event that there is no racing on the Saturday, up to 4 W/L races will be held on the Sunday.

#### 4.0 Class and Division Flags

4.1 The Class flag shall be the Marauder Class Flag, which is the class insignia on a white background.

4.2 The division flag for:

(a) Spinnaker boats	(Div. 1)	Yellow Flag
(b) Non Spinnaker boats	(Div. 2)	Green Flag
(c) Non Standard boats	(Div.3)	White Flag

#### 5.0 Sailing instructions

5.1 These will be available from the Weiti Boating Club's website by 5<sup>th</sup> April 2019.

#### 6.0 Racing Areas

6.1 Racing will be held in the area South of the Whangaparaoa Peninsula.

#### 7.0 The Courses

7.1 These will be described in the sailing instructions.

#### 8.0 Scoring

8.1 The low points scoring system of the World Sailing Racing Rules of Sailing Appendix A shall apply.

8.2 Two (2) races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

#### 9.0 Prizes

9.1 Prize giving will be at the AGM to be held in May.

#### 10.0 Disclaimer of Liability

10.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race.

10.2 Neither the Marauder Owners Association nor the Organising Authority will accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after the regatta.

#### 11.0 Insurance

11.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance.
