Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions

This Notice of Race should be read in conjunction with the Weiti Boating Club Standard Sailing Instructions. If there is a conflict between anything written in the Standard Sailing Instructions and this Notice of Race then the Standard Sailing Instructions will prevail unless noted otherwise in this Notice of Race.

Any clauses not included in this NOR are implied to be the same as those defined in the Weiti Boating Club Standard Sailing Instructions. Where clauses have been modified or added to then these are indicated in italics.

1.0 Rules

- 1.1 *As per Weiti Boating Club Standard Sailing Instructions with the following additions.*
- 1.2 Boats **may not** fly extras (Extras are defined as sails not usually used to advantage to windward).
- 1.3 A female must be at the helm for the entire race, including the pre-start, except as in 1.5 below.
- 1.4 The crew must be at least 50% female.
- 1.5 Should an emergency arise, the owner may take control to correct the situation. I.e. collision avoidance. The helm must be handed back as soon as reasonably possible.

2.0 Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 *As per Weiti Boating Club Standard Sailing Instructions with the following additions.*
- 2.2 There is no entry fee for this race.

3.0 Classes

- 3.1 All boats will race in one class and display a **Yellow** class flag.

4.0 Schedule of races

5.0 Course to be sailed

- 5.1 The course will be a Triangular port course (as outlined in Appendix A.)
- 5.2 All races will start to windward.

6.0 The Start

- 6.1 *As per Weiti Boating Club Standard Sailing Instructions.*

7.0 The Finish

7.1 The finish line will be between a pole on the committee boat at the starboard end and an orange conical buoy at the other.

8.0 After-race function

8.1 Notification of results and the presentation of prizes will be at the Clubhouse after the race. Hot food and refreshments will be available.

9.0 Disclaimer of Liability

9.1 Competitors participate entirely at their own risk. See RRS rule 4, Decision to Race.
9.2 The Organising Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

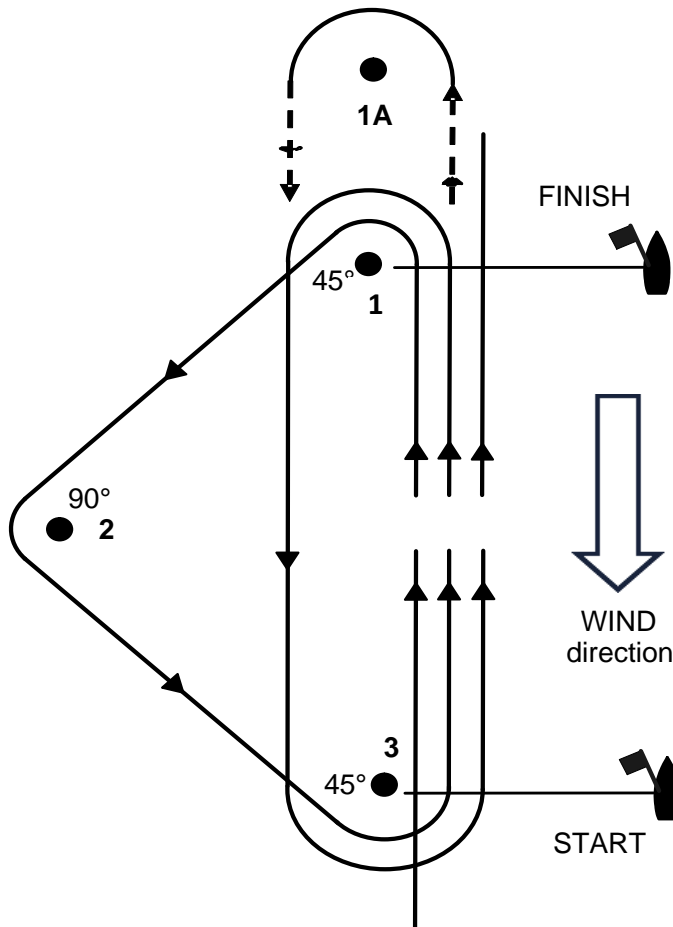
