Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions

This Notice of Race should be read in conjunction with the Weiti Boating Club Standard Sailing Instructions. If there is a conflict between anything written in the Standard Sailing Instructions and this Notice of Race then the Standard Sailing Instructions will prevail unless noted otherwise in this Notice of Race.

Any clauses not included in this NOR are implied to be the same as those defined in the Weiti Boating Club Standard Sailing Instructions. Where clauses have been modified or added to then these are indicated in italics.

1.0 Rules

1.1 *As per Weiti Boating Club Standard Sailing Instructions with the following additions.*

1.1 Boats **may not** fly extras (Extras are defined as sails not usually used to advantage to windward).

1.2 All boats must have a suitable dinghy either towed or stowed on board ready for use. Inflatable dinghies must be fully inflated.

2.0 Eligibility and Entry

2.1 *As per Weiti Boating Club Standard Sailing Instructions.*

2.2 **Whole Series: \$80.00.** – lodged prior to race 2 on 4th November 2017.

2.3 **Individual Race: \$15.00**

3.0 Classes

3.1 All boats will race in one class and display a White class flag.

5.0 Courses

- 5.1 *As per Weiti Boating Club Standard Sailing Instructions with the following additions.*
- 5.2 Courses will be selected from Appendix D of the Standard Sailing Instructions.
- 5.3 Destinations may vary from preferred destination at the discretion of the Race Committee.

6.0 The Start

- 6.1 *As per Weiti Boating Club Standard Sailing Instructions with the following additions.*
- 6.2 All Weiti BC Only races will start at a position off Arkles Bay
- 6.3 Races Combined with GHYC will start in the vicinity of Little Manly Beach.
- 6.4 Any boat starting more than **20** minutes after the Starting Signal will be recorded DNS (Did Not Start) (this varies Item 11.5 of Standard Sailing Instructions).

7.0 The Finish

- 7.1 The finish line shall be as detailed in the Cruising Supplement for the course being sailed
- 7.2 The first boat to finish is encouraged to anchor on the designated finish line in such a position that it can act as a finish boat and record the finishing times of all following boats.
- 7.3 In the absence of a finish boat being on station, all boats shall record their own finish time in hours, minutes and seconds (preferably using a GPS) and advise the designated Committee Boat (as in 15.2 below) of their finish time as soon as practicable after finishing the race
- 7.4 Any boat not having advised its finish time after 90 minutes have elapsed from the last boat finishing shall be recorded DNF (Did Not Finish).

8.0 Safety Regulations

- 8.1 *As per Weiti Boating Club Standard Sailing Instructions.*

9.0 Radio Communications

- 9.1 *As per Weiti Boating Club Standard Sailing Instructions with the following additions.*
- 9.2 The Race Committee shall designate one boat participating in the race as Committee Boat for the race and notify all entrants accordingly.

10.0 Prize giving

- 10.1 Weather permitting, a beach BBQ will be held following each race to which all entrants, other WBC members and their guests are warmly invited. Details will be advised to all WBC boats in the designated anchorage on the day. Day prizes will be awarded at this BBQ.
- 10.2 Prizes and Trophies for Race and series winners will be awarded at a formal prize giving to be held at Weiti BC Clubhouse at a date and time to be advised.

11.0 Disclaimer of Liability

- 11.1 Competitors participate entirely at their own risk. See RRS rule 4, Decision to Race.
- 11.2 The Organising Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
