### NOTICE OF RACE

#### 1.0 RULES

- 1.1 The event is to be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part II, **Category 4** shall apply.
- 1.3 Marauder and Farr 1020 will start separately.
- 1.4 For both classes - Extras:
  - a) Extras are defined as sails not usually used to advantage to windward.
  - b) Divisions 1 & 3 boats may fly extras (no more than 2 spinnakers shall be carried).
  - c) Division 2 is non-spinnaker (no extras).
- 1.5 For Marauder boats, the Marauder Class Rules will apply with the following exceptions:
  - a) Keel stepped masts will be permitted.
  - b) No 1 genoa may be hanked on, foiled or furled.
  - c) No 2 genoa must be smaller than No 1 but does not need to conform to the class size.  
However only one No 2 genoa may be included in the sail wardrobe for this event.
- 1.6 Code of Conduct: Competitors shall comply with any reasonable request from an event official.

#### 2.0 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 2.1 The sailing instructions will be available from the Weiti Boating Club's website by 27<sup>th</sup> March 2023.

#### 3.0 COMMUNICATION

- 3.1 The official notice board is located at the Weiti Boating Club.
- 3.2 All yachts must be equipped with a VHF radio capable of transmitting and receiving on all channels.
- 3.3 On the water, the race committee will make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on VHF radio. The channel is 77.

#### 4.0 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 Entries must be made to the Weiti Boating Club using the online entry form on the Club's website, with payment of the designated entry fee. Entries will **not** be accepted using printed entry forms.
- 4.2 **Entrants must provide a mobile phone number that they can be contacted on while racing.**
- 4.3 Weiti Boating Club reserve the right to accept or refuse any entry.
- 4.4 Entries must be received, and fees paid by Wednesday 22nd March 2023.
- 4.5 Boats entering races must display their correct registration numbers on sails in accordance with the Rule 77 of the Racing Rules of Sailing.

##### Marauder

- 4.6 The event is open to all boats of the Marauder Yachts registered with YNZ and whose owners/skippers are financial members of the Marauder 8.4 Owners Association.
- 4.7 Only Marauders that meet the standard Marauder 8.4 design rules shall be eligible for Marauder 8.4 Association trophies for Division 1 and 2.

##### Farr 1020

- 4.8 The event is open to all Farr 1020 boats registered with YNZ and whose owner/skippers are financial members of the Farr 1020 Owners Association.

#### 5.0 FEES

- 5.1 Entry Fees: \$55 per boat.

#### 6.0 SCHEDULE

<u>Day</u>	<u>Date</u>	<u>No of Races</u>	<u>First warning signal</u>
Saturday	1st April 2023	Up to four W/L races	0855 Farr 1020 0900 Marauder
Sunday	2nd April 2023	One Harbour race	0855 Farr 1020 0900 Marauder

In the event that there is no racing on the Saturday, up to 4 W/L races will be held on Sunday.

Target time for the harbour race is approximately 3 hours so all boats have finished by 1300 hours.

#### 7.0 CLASSES AND DIVISION FLAGS

- 7.1 Marauders – the class insignia on a white background.  
Farr 1020 – the class insignia on a light blue background.
- 7.2 Boats shall display a division flag:
  - (a) Marauder Division 1      Spinnaker boats      Yellow Flag
  - (b) Marauder Division 2      Non Spinnaker boats      Green Flag
  - (c) Marauder Division 3      Non Standard boats      White Flag
  - (d) Farr 1020 Division 1      Spinnaker Boats      Blue Flag
  - (e) Farr 1020 Division 2      Non Spinnaker boats      Black Flag

#### 8.0 RACING AREA

- 8.1 Racing will be held in the area South of the Whangaparaoa Peninsula.

## 9.0 COURSES

- 9.1 The courses will be described in the sailing instructions and consist of Windward/Leeward and courses round fixed harbour marks.

## 10.0 SCORING

- 10.1 The low points scoring system of the Racing Rules of Sailing Appendix A shall apply.
- 10.2 Two (2) races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 10.3 There will be no discards. This changes RRS A2.1.

## 11.0 PRIZES

- 11.1 Prize giving for Marauder will be at the Marauder AGM to be held in May.
- 11.2 Venue and date of the Prize Giving for the Farr 1020 class will be announced by the Farr 1020 Owners Association prior to the regatta.

## 12.0 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 12.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race.
- 12.2 Neither the Marauder Owners Association, Farr 1020 Association nor the Organising Authority will accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after the regatta.

## 13.0 INSURANCE

- 13.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance.
