Notice to Competitors and Race Management Volunteers Level 3 step 1

All competitors and Race Management volunteers must make themselves aware of COVID-19 and the risks involved. Information is available on the COVID website https://www.health.govt.nz/

As a prerequisite to entering, sailing or Race Management volunteering in a Weiti Boating Club race, you agree your personal information may be shared with the local Public Health Authorities to enable rapid contact tracing if a participant or volunteer at the event becomes ill with COVID-19 or has been in contact with a confirmed case of COVID-19.

The following mandatory precautions must be taken to be able to race / Race Management volunteer in all Weiti Boating Club races.

- Under level 3.1 you can only race with crew/people from your own household bubble onboard your boat.
- 2) Mandatory Contact tracing of all crew, this is the responsibility of the skipper. Contact details of all race crew must also be provided to the Weiti Boating Club by email info@weiti.co.nz
- 3) You should not let any person onto your boat who display flu-like or COVID-19 symptoms. Ask people who display flu-like symptoms to self-isolate.
- **4)** Skippers are responsible for disinfecting surfaces on board their boats before and after use, with regular cleaning of high use items or handhelds like VHF, winches, winch handles and door handles.
- 5) Wash sailing gloves and shared equipment like life jackets after every use.
- 6) Skippers are encouraged to advise crew to maintain good hygiene like regular washing and drying of hands or using hand sanitiser and encourage good cough/sneeze etiquette and avoiding touching your face.
- 7) There will be no prize giving or gatherings after the race until further notice. Prizes can be collected from the club office at a later date when Covid Levels allow.
- 8) Maintain physical distancing of 2 metres wherever possible while at the club, especially from people you do not know.
- 9) One in one out when using the dinghy lockers.
- 10) The clubhouse is closed until further notice.
- 11) Face coverings must be worn while on club grounds.
